Both girls enjoy summer swim league in our neighborhood and playing for hours upon hours together. They can't wait to have a little sibling to share their bond with.








Our Home




Traveling


We enjoy getting away together and exploring new places. We usually take one or two “big” vacations per year – Disney is a family favorite, and travel to the beach every summer for a few days.
